

## **Grades 7 & 8 Supply List for 2017-2018**

In the upper grades, color-coded folders, binders, and notebooks are **highly recommended** as these students are learning organizational skills.

### Homeroom Supplies:

- ✓ At least 2 boxes of facial tissue
- ✓ At least 1 roll of paper towels
- ✓ 2 reams of white copy paper
- ✓ 1 ream of colored copy paper
- ✓ 1 bottle of hand sanitizer
- ✓ At least 1 container of cleaning wipes (Clorox, Lysol, etc.)
- ✓ 1 box of colored pencils or markers to be shared by classroom
- ✓ 1 pair of scissors & 1 glue stick/bottle of glue to be shared by classroom
- ✓ 1 box of pens and 1 box of pencils to be shared by class
- ✓ 1 box of Ziploc bags (gallon size)

### Supplies for all classes (may need to be refilled throughout the year):

- ✓ Loose leaf paper (college), graph paper, and one pack of 3x5 inch index cards
- ✓ Assortment of pens (black/blue and red) and highlighters
- ✓ 1 pack of #2 pencils (mechanical are preferred) for personal use
- ✓ Soft Pencil Pouch (must fit in 3 ring binder)
- ✓ USB flash drive (at least 1 GB)
- ✓ 3 ring binder (Zipper binder is highly recommended)
- ✓ ½" Wide 3 Ring Binder (Leadership Binder)

### Language Arts (Yellow):

- ✓ 2- minimum 4 subject spiral notebook (for grammar, notes and drafting, etc)
- ✓ Post-It notes (Post-it brand works best!...will need throughout the year)
- ✓ 1- yellow folder (plastic would work best)
- ✓ red pens for peer edits

### Math (Blue):

- ✓ 2 spiral graph paper notebooks (1 per semester, 3 hole punched to fit in binder)
- ✓ Pencil sharpener or lead for refillable mechanical pencil (mechanical preferred)
- ✓ Calculator with a fraction key (MANDATORY)

### Social Studies (Red):

- ✓ ½" Wide 3 Ring Binder (Social Studies Binder)
- ✓ 100 Count Plastic Page Protectors
- ✓ Composition Notebook

### Science (Green):

- ✓ 1 composition notebook (graphing preferred)
- ✓ 1 two-pocket folder with prongs
