

2017-2018 Newberry Math & Science Academy School Rules

In addition to the items prohibited in the CPS Student Code of Conduct, Walter L. Newberry Math & Science Academy students are held to a high behavioral standard:



- Students at our school work hard to live the 7 Habits of Highly Effective People
- Students act in a courteous manner to one another, staff members and visitors to the building
- Students never open school entrance/exit doors to strangers or visitors. All visitors are buzzed into the school by an adult at the Main Office
- Students abide by all school rules, including the Cellular Phone Contract
- Students are to arrive to school on time, which is 7:30am. Attendance is factored into the participation portion of every class.
- Students transition in hallways quietly. Classroom teachers will set the behavioral expectation for their class transition. No more than a whisper is acceptable
- During emergency drills, all students transition silently

To keep a safe and orderly environment, the following items are prohibited on school premises:

- Weapons or weapon look-alikes
- Skateboards
- Chewing gum
- Toys (except those approved for outdoor recess such as jump ropes)
- Large amount of money
- Purses while traveling through the hallways
- Backpacks on wheels do not fit in the lockers and can be dangerous when students are traveling through the hallways
- Flip flops, slide sandals or any other footwear other than dress shoes and/or gym shoes

Newberry Academy personnel may confiscate these items if seen in your possession and give them to school administration. Parents will be required to come to the building to retrieve any confiscated items.

Anti-Bullying Policy

In accordance with the CPS Anti-Bullying Policy, bullying behaviors (including physical, verbal, emotional or sexual in nature) of any kind will not be allowed on school property, school buses or via Internet sites and social media. Students and parents may report allegations of bullying behaviors to school personnel so that appropriate investigation may take place.

All students enrolled at Walter L. Newberry Math & Science Academy are to abide by the rules laid out in this agreement.
