



WHAT IS A LOCAL SCHOOL COUNCIL?

LSCs include parents, teachers, and community members. Depending on your connection to the school, you can run as either a parent or community representative.

The LSC's primary responsibilities are to select their school's principal, approve their school's annual budget, and their school's plans to improve academic progress.



HOW CAN I RUN FOR THE LSC?

Complete the LSC Candidate Forms, which can be picked up at your school or at cps.edu/lselections

Return the forms IN PERSON to:

Your school by **March 2nd, 2018 at 3pm** or the Office of Local School Council Relations by **February 20th, 2018 at 3pm**.

Elementary Schools: April 18th , 2018

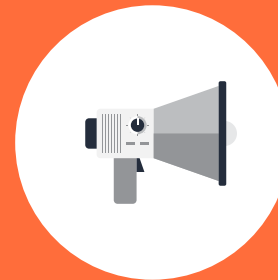
High Schools: April 19th, 2018



PARENT CANDIDATES MUST:

- Be the parent or legal guardian of a child enrolled in the school
- NOT be employed by Chicago Public Schools

NOTE: When forms are dropped off Parent Candidates should bring 2 forms of ID, one of which proves that you are the parent of a child in the school (student's report card, child's birth certificate, etc.)



COMMUNITY CANDIDATES MUST:

- Be at least 18 years old
- NOT be employed by Chicago Public Schools
- Live in the attendance area or voting district of the school

NOTE: When forms are dropped off Community candidates should bring two forms of ID, one of which includes their current address (driver's license, utility bill, etc.)
