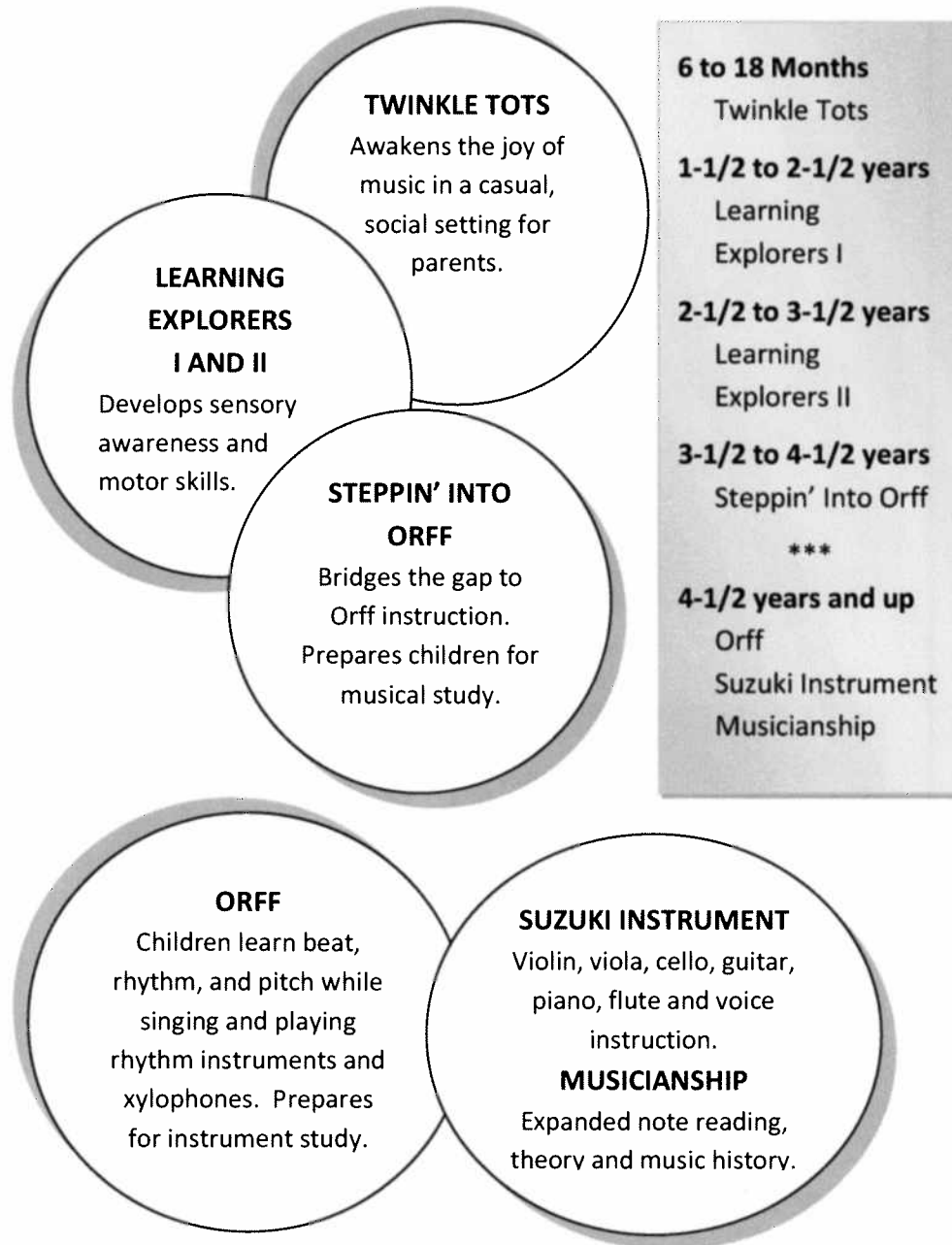

The Suzuki-Orff Program

Our Early Childhood program, BabySTEPS®, a prelude to Orff and instrument instruction, is offered in a relaxed setting of group classes for parent and child.



Why music education at Suzuki-Orff?

Our one-of-a-kind sequential program provides a fusion of knowledge, skill, and artistic sensitivity combining both Suzuki and Orff methodologies.

What is Suzuki?

Suzuki Talent Education is based on the premise that a child can learn music skills the way they learn to speak -- through exposure, imitation, and encouragement -- in other words, the "mother tongue" approach. Parent participation and peer interaction are essential elements to the learning process.



What is Orff ?

The Orff-Schulwerk method was developed by famed composer, Carl Orff using children's natural, playful impulses toward movement and vocal expression to teach music concepts. In our interactive group classes children explore beat, rhythm, and pitch. Once familiar with these concepts, students are introduced to rhythm and melodic instruments -- xylophones, glockenspiels, and hand drums, enabling the joy of ensemble playing and eventually early note reading.

Suzuki-Orff Integrated Approach



While each program is complete in itself, Orff classes are taught simultaneously with Suzuki instruction. Note reading readiness skills are introduced through Orff instruction.

When coordination and technical skill are sufficiently developed on the instrument, note reading skills learned in Orff are transferred to the child's instrument. Note reading is furthered later in our Musicianship classes.
