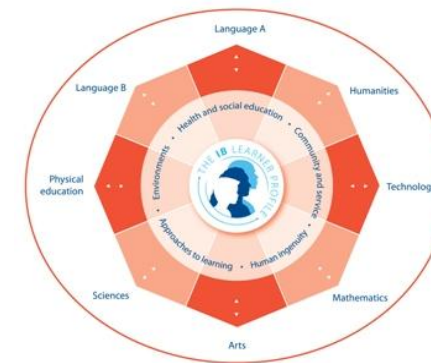
The **International Baccalaureate (IB)** has been a recognized leader in the field of international education since 1968. It offers three challenging, high-quality programs that help students ages 3 to 19 to develop the intellectual, personal, emotional and social skills to live, learn and work in a rapidly globalizing world. There are approximately 861,000 IB students at 3,050 schools in 139 countries. ***The Chicago Public Schools has more IB Programmes than any other school district in the United States.***

The **IB Middle Years Programme**, offered in select Chicago Public High Schools for students in grades 9 and 10, provides a framework of academic challenge that encourages students to embrace and understand the connections between traditional subjects and the real world, and become critical and reflective thinkers.

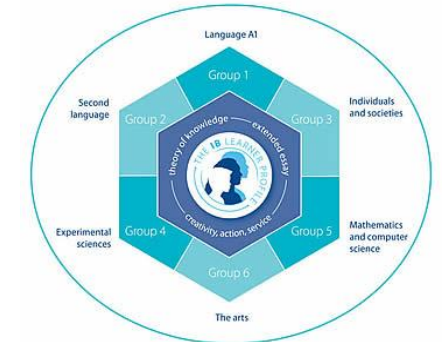
The **IB Diploma Programme** is a comprehensive and challenging pre-university program for academically advanced and highly motivated students in grades 11 and 12. The program is widely recognized around the globe for its high academic standards. The IB curriculum is rigorous and challenging. IB Diploma Programme graduates are better prepared for college courses and attend and successfully complete college or university study at a higher rate than their peers. They enter the world culturally and internationally aware, open-minded, and confident in a language other than English.

In a recent analysis of the IB Programme in the Chicago Public Schools, the **Consortium on Chicago School Research at the University of Chicago** suggests that:

- ***“IBDP [IB Diploma Programme] students in CPS attend four-year colleges, attend more selective colleges, and persist in college at higher rates than similar students in honors programs and selective enrollment high schools.”***
- ***“IBDP students are entering college with strong academic skills and powerful confidence about their ability to engage and excel in college courses.”***

\$\$\$ In 2011, Chicago Public Schools IB graduates were offered over \$27,050,000 in college scholarships. \$\$\$
